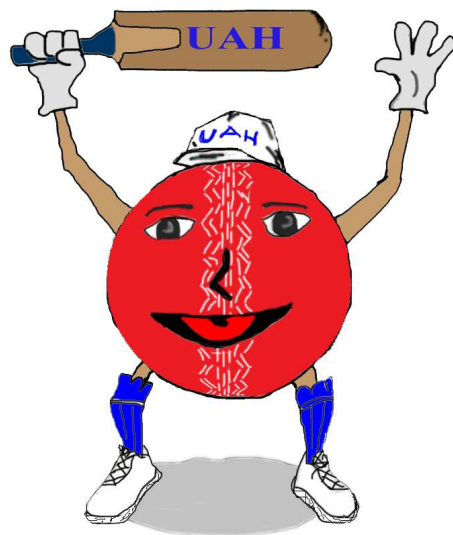

Fall '04 Challenger Cricket Trophy

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. The teams will be grouped into two pools.
2. Each team in a pool will play every other team the pool during the preliminary round robin league. The top two teams from each pool will play in the semifinals.

3. Each innings in the tournament including the semifinals shall consist of sixteen (16) overs with a maximum of four overs for each bowler. The same rules hold good through out the tournament.
4. The finals will be a 20 over game with a maximum of 5 overs for each bowler.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A win is awarded 4 points and a tie is awarded 2 points. In case of a no show from both the teams, 0 points are awarded.
2. No restrictions on field placements including the wicket keeper.
3. No LBW and no leg-byes. However, byes are allowed.
4. Hard (MRI) tennis balls will be used.
5. The change of ball will be based on umpire's discretion.
6. If two or more teams have equal points, then their head to head results would be used to break the tie. In case, this does not resolve the standings, the net run rate is considered.
7. Run rate is calculated according to the formula:
 $(Runs\ scored - runs\ conceded) / (Number\ of\ overs\ played)$
8. in case of rain, umpires decision will be final.
9. In case of any team member having a clarification, he has to report it to the umpires or the captain of their respective teams.
10. The Captains, Umpires and the Organizers will sort out any discrepancies.
11. A match is considered forfeited if the team does not show up 10 minutes past the scheduled start of play. The opposite team will earn 2 points.
12. In case of any event not covered by the above rules or in case of any conflicts, the decision of the UAHCC committee will be final.
13. Drinks would be served by UAHCC during the tournament.

- **Registration forms should be submitted to UAHCC by September 15th, 2004 by 5:00pm and is based on first come first serve basis.**
- **Please register at the earliest due to the limited number of teams that can participate in the tournament.**
- **Registration fee of \$50.00 is due by the beginning of the tournament.**
